W.C.Y.C. RULES

1. All members shall be responsible for their family and guests.
2. Children 16 years and younger shall be supervised by a parent or guardian.
3. No fishing, running or "horse play" will be permitted on docks or grounds.
4. Main runways shall be kept clear, at all times.
5. All boats will make use of spring lines. Boats occupying outside slips with interslip must tie-up to the polemates or tide-slides on the interslip pilings by use of an additional spring line.
6. No open fires are permitted on vessels or docks.
7. No in-water dingy/tender shall exceed twelve feet. Ability to store dingy/tender and location of storage shall be at the discretion of the dockmaster.
8. No portion of a members boat, bow or dingy shall extend over the main runway.
9. Members and guests shall comply with all rules and regulations pertaining to marine toilets and water pollution.
10. The ramp shall be used for member's boats only for launching, hauling and emergencies. Boat trailers will not be permitted to be left in the parking lot overnight.
11. All sail boats shall leave and return to their slips under auxiliary power.
12. All halyards shall be tied-off masts at slips, or the Dock Master may do so to prevent annoyance to others.
13. When using portable battery chargers, battery cables should be disconnected to prevent electrolysis.
14. Pets are not allowed to roam around freely at the Club. All dogs or other pets must be on a leash (or carried in the appropriate cage) by the member.
15. Fueling and/or storage of fuel tanks or fuel containers on the docks is absolutely prohibited.
16. Members and guests shall, at all times, conduct themselves lawfully and with civility so as not to cause annoyance or inconvenience to persons or damage to property or premises.
17. Excessive electrical usage resulting in a compromise of the safety and welfare of the club is prohibited. Member(s) will be subject to surcharge for additional electrical expense to club because of excessive electrical usage. Surcharge will be assessed at the discretion of the B.O.D.
18. Members arriving on or after June 1st are required to give the Club five (5) days advance notice of the arrival of their boat at the Club. Members must notify the Dock Master in the event that they will vacate their slip for a period of overnight or longer.
19. All Members' boats are required to fly a WCYC burgee. A new burgee will be provided to every member at the beginning of the new season. There will be a charge for the Burgee on the second half bill. Probationary Members may fly the club Burgee, but are not required to.
